- Computer games developers make games for the internet, mobile phone, PC's and games consoles. This sector is projected to grow by 2.8% by 2024 creating 8,600 extra jobs.

You'll usually need 5 GCSE's at grade 9 to 4, for A Level 3 qualification such as A-Levels, a BTEC in creative media production/games development or related subjects. You can also do an advance or higher apprenticship in creative and digitial media or software development. You can build your experience by starting as a computer games tester.
