

## Sixth Form Uniform

### School Uniform Policy

The Governing Body believes that our uniform is essential to the ethos of our school community as it establishes a clear sense of identity, fosters a sense of inclusive belonging, and engenders both positive behaviour and self-discipline, which in turn supports teaching and learning.

#### Boys:

- a dark coloured smart jacket/blazer
- dark coloured, smart tailored trousers – not jeans
- short or long sleeved shirt
- Sixth Form tie with crest in House colour (available from school)
- smart dark shoes
- plain jumper/cardigan – enabling tie to be seen – (this is not to be worn in place of the blazer/jacket)
- no rings, piercings or other jewellery
- no hooded, zip-up tops or round neck tops

#### Girls:

- a dark coloured smart jacket/suit.
- dark coloured, smart tailored trousers (no denim, leggings or skinny trousers) **or** black skirt (knee length and no stretch material) available from office wear sections in High Street stores
- shirt or blouse with collar
- Sixth Form tie with crest in House colour (available from school)
- smart dark shoes no open toes/sandals/flip flops
- **One** pair of stud or small loop earrings. No facial piercings, large rings or other large jewellery
