

St Thomas More High School - External Exam Centre

We are once again welcoming candidates from the Home School community and post-18 education into our exam centre to undertake their GCSE's / A-Levels.

St Thomas More is currently registered with the following exam boards:

AQA
Pearson Edexcel
OCR
Eduqas (part of WJEC)

We are able to offer written exams in a host of subjects, but we currently are unable to offer any practical subject support or support for those subjects that require a Non-Examined Assessment. This includes but is not limited to Physical Education, Food Technology, Design Technology and Art.

There is also the option of doing an **iGCSE** instead of the standard GCSE. The iGCSE's we accept are with Pearson Edexcel and they can negate the need for coursework (dependant on the specification chosen), spoken language endorsements or practical Science/Geography endorsements.

We offer places for those exams taking place in the Summer Season (May/June) each academic year. Maths and English resits are available in the November season – but candidates must have turned 16 years of age in the August prior.

Registration

Registrations open each academic year in September. If you would like to register as an External Candidate at St Thomas More High School there is a registration form available to download from our website and it can be emailed to: exams@st-thomasmore.southend.sch.uk

You can also use the above email to request an appointment to be made to collect the form and also talk to us about how we can assist.

As a private/external candidate you are responsible for ensuring you are aware of the correct specification / qualification code and information, and making yourself familiar with the regulations for examinations as laid out by JCQ. *Deadlines for entry are 1st **October** for November Season and 1st **February** for June (Summer) Season*

Fees

Fees for the exam will vary depending on what qualification you are sitting:-

GCSE/iGCSE (excluding Combined Science/MFL)	£190
GCSE/iGCSE MFL (Modern Foreign Language)	£210
GCSE/iGSCE Combined Science	£220
A-Level	£260

GCSE and A-level course that require a spoken exam may be subject to additional examiners fees. This can be discussed with the Exams Officer via the email above.
